From The Pastor's Perspective

Deacons have drawn my attention in recent days, as last week I had occasion to visit our eldest, Deacon Dan Graham.

Deacon Dan has struggled for the past year with and on-going bout of serious illness and is currently living at the Friendship Village nursing facility in South St. Louis County.

Deacons Bob Brunton, David Ewing, and Bob Mayo, our current diaconal team, are a real source of blessing to us all in the great Ministries of Word, Sacrament, and Service.
