From The Pastor's Perspective

As you entered Church today, you may have noticed a slight “impediment” at the front doors – the result of a major repair that may well have needed attention since Church was renovated a decade ago.

In my first meeting with Msgr. J, upon my appointment as pastor, he noted a number of issues around the parish plant that would need attention, “sooner or later”.

Besides leaky roofs and walls, erosion issues, and a possible threat of multiple heating and air-conditioning failures, he pointed out that after making use of a mobile camera, an investigation of the major drain running from the Church's roof beneath the sidewalk in front of Church had collapsed, was not functional, and should really be replaced.

As there were no funds to address the issue at that time—I filed the project away for some future date.

Thankfully, since the retirement of the parish debt in September, we have incorporated a means for addressing such issues with little relative stress.

Our monthly “*Capital Campaign Prevention Collection*” which has been commended to the generosity of our faithful donors both the envelope packet and automatic payment program has come to the rescue.

To all of you who have so generously supported this important and easy method of building our parish savings to address such inevitable crises, I offer you many thanks.

Hopefully with continued support we will be more than ready to address the next “impediment” with equal ease!

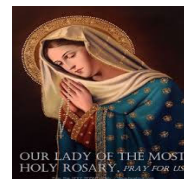
