From The Pastor's Perspective

On Wednesday of this past week, I recalled and celebrated for once, a commemoration that sadly I have too often overlooked.

It wasn't a saint's festival—my birthday--anniversary of my ordination—nor the memorial day for the passing of some loved one from my past—but the date of my baptism into the life of God and the community of Christ's Church.

64 years ago, in the Church of Saints Mary and Joseph, way down in old Carondelet, my good parents and godparents carried me to the waters of baptism as an infant.

It was the beginning of a journey of which, though blissfully unaware at the time, offered to me the great promise and hope of Life Eternal, an uncommon grace shared by men and women of faith, saints and sinners of every age, land, and background, who compose the Mystical Body of Christ.

On Wednesday, I gave special thanks to the Lord God for all those good folks who have supported me by word and faithful example through the years: family and friends, teachers and co-workers, some who have given good example, and others who have shared consolation or needed challenge.

What was the date of your baptism?

Perhaps as Lent progresses, you too might benefit from time of reflection and act of gratitude for the spiritual gift that was shared with you on your baptismal day.

It was a blessing for me, and maybe it could be so for you too!
