From The Pastor's Perspective

What happened to the Cross and the Statues?
It's like they have disappear or blend into the woodwork with those greenish veils.

Have you notice that the Church calendar at home has very few Saints commemorated during Lent?

It is not by accident since our Lenten focus is not on the celebration of the saints in glory but on the very real struggles we experience in uncovering our way to the fulfillment promised us in the Kingdom of God.

We need to look closely to see and hear how we are to follow Jesus more selflessly in Lent's final days.

Apparently the old custom of veiling sacred images in the final fourteen days of Lent came about to urge folks to recognize that the accustomed way of looking at things of faith needs to be overturned.

The glory of the fulfillment of the Paschal Mystery will be once more be unveiled to us at the celebration of the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday.

In these final days of Lent, with the beloved images of the holy ones obscured – we can take time to reflect upon the ways our words and actions have the same obscuring effect on the world around us hoping to see Christ in us.

Where is the action of Christ's saving love being made visible in you and me?

We are reminded that we need to become clearer signs of the holy plan of God lived here and now, as "suffer" the minor irritation of the temporary loss of holy images within the Church until Easter.

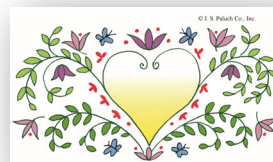

New Online Giving Program Begins May 1, 2019

After twelve years of using the *Faith Direct* Electronic offertory program, on this past Thursday Saint Elizabeth Parish is making a change by adopting the Our Sunday Visitor's "**Online Giving**" donation program.

Our Parish Finance Council, evaluated with care programs comparable to what we had become accustomed to and found that "**Online Giving**" to be a preferable electronic offertory vendor because:

- It is more cost effective (much smaller administrative fees)
- It has a better better interface and office support system
- It offers more payment flexibility
- It also offers improved access to your personal account with more control of your giving options.

To accomplish this transition without a hitch, we ask all subscribers to the current "*Faith Direct*" program to shift their enrollment to "**Online Giving**" by April 24th by following these steps:

- 1) Please, go to the "*Online Giving link*" on our Parish Website: www.setonscene.org.
- 2) Select "*Create New Account*" and follow the step by step navigation to set up your account.

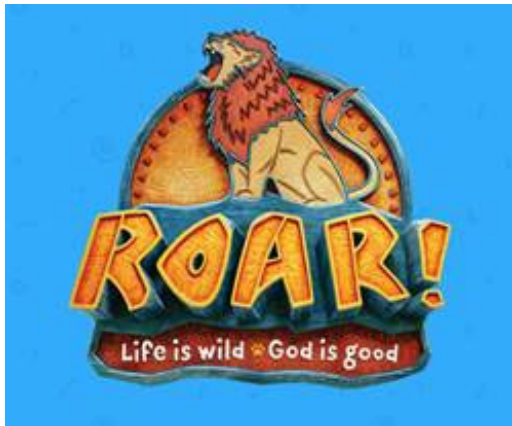
