## The Pastor's Perspective

In the past few weeks I have noticed, perhaps due to recent inoculations of some, once again we are in need of the help of ushers before Holy Mass to seat folks in a way maximizing our capacity while maintaining necessary distancing.

This may be an acute need during Holy Week and on Easter Sunday.

Anyone interested assisting in this ministry is asked to call Sue Berthold at the Parish Office (636-946-6717) so she can work up a schedule for the various Masses.

As Lent reaches the midpoint today, the days of Holy Week are fast approaching on the horizon, so some details need to be addressed.

Once again attendance at the various services of Holy Week here at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton will be in keeping with the policies laid down by the St. Charles County Department of Public Health.

We continue to request anyone entering the church for any of the celebrations:

- To wear a facial covering
- To use hand sanitizer
- To maintain proper social distancing
- And continue to show common courtesy at all times to those around them.

Attendance at each service continues to be regulated to one quarter of the church's capacity—which is 150 persons.

The rites of the Sacred Triduum have been reworked to eliminate components that may be of potential concern to public health.

This year there will be:

- No congregational processions
- No washing of feet (the Mandatum)
- No visitation of the place of reposition
- No physical veneration of the cross

On **March 28<sup>th</sup>, Passion Sunday**, the usual Weekend Mass Schedule will be observed with the tradition of the blessing of palms at each of the five celebrations.

On **April 1<sup>st</sup>, Holy Thursday**, only the *Mass of the Lord Supper* will be celebrated at 7:30 PM.

**April 2<sup>nd</sup> Good Friday**, the Stations of the Cross will be offered at 12 Noon, with a *final opportunity for confessions* following—then at 7:30 PM the *Liturgy of the Lord's Passion* will be celebrated.

On **April 3<sup>rd</sup>, Holy Saturday**, there will be no liturgical or sacramental observances except the *Vigil Mass of the Lord's Rising* at 8:00 PM.

On **April 4<sup>th</sup>, Easter Sunday**, the Glory of the Lord's Resurrection will be celebrated with three morning Masses at 6:30, 8:30 and 10:30 AM—there will be no Regional Youth Mass at 6:30 PM that night.

As these great days of Holy Week approach may we all grow in the desire to be well prepared for their proclamation of Jesus as our Crucified and Risen Lord.
